

Kentucky Veterans Hall of Fame Scholarship Application

The KVHOF Scholarship criteria have changed. A written essay is no longer required. The scholarship is open only to children, grandchildren or great-grandchildren of Alumni of the KVHOF. The applicant must be a high school junior or senior or a student currently enrolled in a college, university or vocational school.

To apply, the student must submit the following information on a separate page: 1. Your high school/college experience (i.e. GPA, awards, clubs or teams you were on, etc). 2. Any civic, religious, social, or other volunteer involvements. 3. Any work history you may have. 4. Specific information about your academic/career objectives. 5. Any information you can provide about financial requirements/needs. 6. A digital photo suitable for use in our brochure about your scholarship selection. If the application is not complete, with all requested information, including photo, the application will NOT be considered.
